

◆ CLASS OF LECTURE & PRACTICE

Intellectual curiosity, this is the distinction of the people who come to our class. They are not necessarily religious. But they do want to know the heart and soul of the Bible.

Recently the Bible in Japanese has been published in the “Shinsho” style, a readable form Bunshun–shinsho (2010), by a secular publisher. We select currently important themes, read the Bible of the themes, followed by brief comments, and listen to the Noh drama stories of the same themes. The demonstration of the highlights of Noh dance and Noh song follows. Those who wish to perform can dance and sing after the leader. The class ends in Q&A and discussion.

We select speakers among the participants and they talk on the subjects of their choice, either related or unrelated to the themes of the day. Q&A and discussion follow the talks.



In the Christian calendar the Easter 2011 is 4/24, the Ascension 6/2, & the Pentecost 6/12. We discuss on life, death and after-life as subjects of not only religion but also of natural science, including the brain death and the organ transplantation.
